School Supplies:

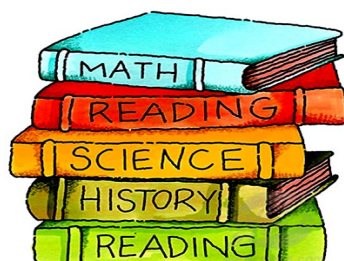
A list of required school supplies is attached to this letter. Please ensure your child comes prepared with all necessary materials.

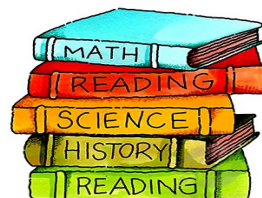
