Pastor Brent Waldon

Pastor Brent D. Waldon, Sr. was born and raised in Sumter, South Carolina. He completed a Bachelor of Arts degree in Religion from Oakwood College (now Oakwood University) in Huntsville, Alabama, and a Master of Arts degree in Ministry from Andersonville Theological Seminary in Camilla, Georgia.

Pastor Waldon was extended a call into pastoral ministry with the Southeastern Conference of Seventh-day Adventists by the late President James Edgecombe and became one of the original pastors of the newly organized Southeastern Conference of Seventh-day Adventists. For nearly forty years, Pastor Waldon and his wife, Jacqueline have worked and served twelve churches and three schools across the Southeastern Conference territory from Waycross/Brunswick, Georgia to the north and as far south as Miami, Florida.

Adventist Christian Education was a highlight of his ministry. Pastor Waldon and Jacqueline were active in ALL of the church schools they pastored, but Daughter of Zion Junior Academy (DOZJA) was extra special. Countless hours have been dedicated to building up the Kingdom of God through Adventist Christian Education and DOZJA was blessed by their commitment.

Pastor Waldon's service to the constituents of Southeastern Conference has extended to Stewardship/Trust Services Director, Ministerial Director, and now Vice President for Pastoral and Church Leadership Development.

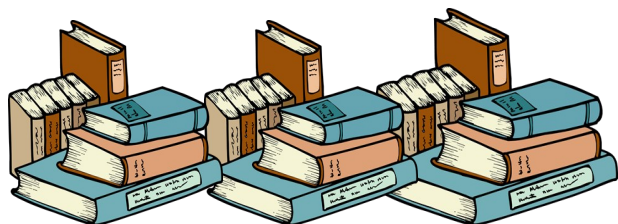

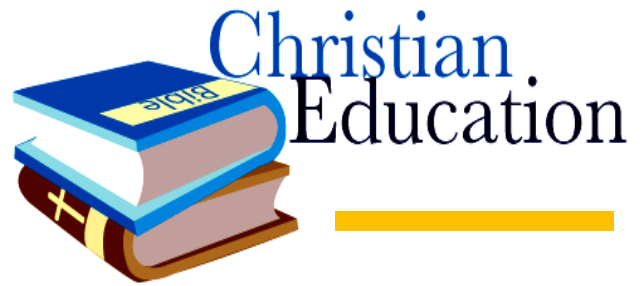
